

**New weed management resources now available
March 9, 2017**

Two new turf weed management resources are available for purchase at the [Nebraska Extension Marketplace](#) store.

1. The 2017 [Guide for Weed, Disease, and Insect Management in Nebraska](#) focuses on pesticide efficacy data collected and summarized by UNL researchers in crop and noncrop areas, and has detailed drawings to help with weed identification.



2. The 2017 edition of [Turfgrass Weed Control for Professionals](#) is a new resource to the marketplace this year. This publication is annually available through Purdue Extension. This updated version includes input from us and other turf experts within the North Central Turfgrass and Environment working group to address regional differences in weed populations and control strategies. The guide has images and descriptions of 105 weeds, describes control strategies for difficult weeds, and comprehensively summarizes turfgrass herbicide efficacy on various weeds, and safety on turfgrass species (including buffalograss). Only hardcopies are available through the UNL marketplace, but a [digital version](#) is also available through the Purdue Extension Education Store.
