

**Save the date: Turfgrass Field Day will be virtual in 2020**

**June 4, 2020**

Long before the disruption by the Corona virus pandemic, the UNL turf team, in conversation with the NTA Board, decided to have a virtual field day in 2020. One of the justifications for going virtual is the ability to capture digital still and video throughout the growing season to better represent and describe what the research is showing. We will put this in a series of videos and make them available to participants for later viewing, staff training or justification of product purchase to decision makers. The new format will also not be restricted by field day stop time limits. Some videos may be less than 5 minutes while others may go longer to better describe concepts and research results.
